
JMG Performing Daily at Irvine Barclay Theatre Ithough there are almost 175 performing





Since most ransomware attacks come in the form of an email attachment, you

should not open any you were not expecting, or if the sender is not known to you. You should use the same caution when presented with URL's you don't recognize

Proactively, you can help protect your system by completing all Windows updates

Also, pass the word. All employees need to understand that with today's advanced ransomware techniques, you only have to visit a website - You DO NOT have to click anything on the website - to infect a company's system with data encrypting

and ensure that your antivirus solution is updated and functioning correctly.

If you are among our clients looking at upgrading your phone lines to new "Digital" or VoIP lines, you should be aware that some of our clients have switched only to learn afterward that their security

Also, even if it does work in the beginning, changes by your phone provider at a later date could

systems could no longer communicate. Due to the way "Digital" or VoIP lines work, the data transmitted from the alarm system often is unable to reach the central station once phone lines are converted.


